

TEXAS DYBASEBALL

Umpire Certification Instructions

- 1. All DYB umpires must have attended a DYB Umpire clinic or have a minimum of two years of TASO experience.
- 2. All DYB umpires also must complete the umpire certification test on-line annually. This includes all local league umpires.
- 3. Taking the certification test will also register umpires with Texas DYB. Make sure that phone numbers and addresses are correct. Taking the on-line test is the only way to be certified and registered as a DYB umpire.
- 4. Umpires who want to work district, regional, state and World Series tournaments must have completed the on-line test and certification successfully. Certification will require taking an annual on-line test. All questions are DYB rules and tournament policy questions.
- 5. An umpire must score 90% on the test. The test may be retaken until an 90% score is made.
- 6. There will be a \$30 fee to take the test. The \$30 will cover the annual DYB Umpire Registration and retaking the test as many times as needed.
- 7. Upon completing the certification test, a DYB patch, tournament calendar, DYB Rulebook and Texas Rule Supplement will be mailed to the participant.
- 8. Umpire clinics will be scheduled in districts annually. DYB districts can adopt a district policy for how often an umpire must attend a clinic. Each participant at the clinics shall pay \$10 to attend. The clinics will cover rules, policies, and on-the-field mechanics. The \$10 clinic fee shall be used to pay the clinic UIC for conducting the clinic.
